TIPS & TRICKS Common Types of Medical Fraud HEALTH **CAAs** reported by the FBI's White Collar Crime Program



Provider Focused Fraud Duplicate Billing - multiple billings for the same services, usually on separate bills to avoid notice

Services Not Rendered - billing for services not performed, including specific codes, partial or full treatments, and falsified dates of service

Unbundling - Inflating billing by separating out services that should be billed together at a reduced rate

Upcoding - Inflating costs by billing for a higher level service than that actually provided



Individual Focused Fraud

Baited Marketing - obtaining individual's information voluntarily for the purpose of fake billing, fake

insurance, etc

Identity Theft - stealing another person's identity to run up a medical claim

Fake Doctors - individual posing as doctors or providing services in a medical setting without proper licensing

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Prescription Fraud

Forged Prescriptions - falsifying prescriptions, entire prescriptions, or signatures

> **Re-Routing Prescriptions - obtaining** subscriptions to sell or share

Rotating Doctor / Pharmacy Prescriptions -Using multiple doctors or pharmacies without the other's knowledge to obtain an excessive prescriptions





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
